Level 1 (Grades 7-9)

Check in starts at 12:00 P.M. and contest starts at 1:45 P.M. sharp.

- All team members must read behavioral contract/ contest guidelines and bring it signed by all members when they check in.
- All team members must check in together.
- Check in starts 12:00 P.M. and ends at 1:15 P.M (Dhuhr prayer will be at 1:30 P.M.)
- If your team's name starts with the letters A to H check in at 12:00 P.M., letters I to P check in at 12:20 P.M., and letters Q to Z check in at 12:40 P.M.
- Each participant will receive a Seerah Quest short-sleeved T-shirt and a name badge.
- The T-shirt is a must to wear for all participants to be identified from general audience. Please know your size, be ready to wear it quickly. Girls can wear a long sleeve shirt under the short-sleeve T-Shirt.
- No check in after 1:15 P.M.
- Expected time to finish level 1 is 4:15 P.M.

Level 2 (Grades 10 - 12)

- All team members must check in together.
- Check in starts 3:00 P.M. and ends at 4:15 P.M. (Asr prayer starts at 4:30 P.M.)
- If your team's name starts with the letters A to H check in at 3:00 P.M., letters I to P check in at 3:20 P.M., and letters Q to Z check in at 3:40 P.M.
- Each participant will receive a Quran Quest short-sleeved T-shirt and a name badge.
- The T-shirt is a must to wear for all participants to be identified from general audience. Please know your size, be ready to wear it quickly. Girls must wear a long sleeve shirt under the short-sleeve T-Shirt and a scarf.
- No check in after 4:00 P.M.
- Expected time to finish level 2 is 7:30 P.M. (Al-Maghrib prayer starts at 6:44 P.M.)

Level 3

Families Or Friends (18 years +)

Check in starts at 9:00 A.M. and contest starts at 10:00 A.M. sharp.

- All team members must read behavioral contract/ contest guidelines and bring it signed by all members when they check in.
- All team members must check in together.
- Check in starts at 9:00 A.M. and ends 9:50 A.M.
- If your team's name start with the letters A to H please arrive at 9:00 A.M., letters I to P arrive at 9:15 A.M., and letters Q to Z arrive 9:30 A.M.
- Each participant will receive a Seerah Quest short-sleeved T-shirt.
- The T-shirt is a must to wear for all participants to be identified from general audience. Only women can be exempted from wearing the T-shirt if they wish. Girls must wear a long sleeve shirt under the short-sleeve T-Shirt and a scarf.
- No check in after 9:50 A.M.
- Late teams are not permitted to the competition and are disqualified.
- Expected time to finish level 3 is 12:30 P.M.

Competition Process:

- Each Team will be seated around a table. Two blank sheets, a pen, and a team sign will be provided on each table.
- Each team should identify its pen owner/writer, and its team leader who will make the final decision on the answer.
- All teams must listen to the contest rules and obey them.
- All teams will participate simultaneously in all rounds
- All teams will answer both multiple choice and short answer questions.
- Top scoring teams will be announced after the final round and will receive a prize additional to the T-shirt reward that all participants receive at the start of competition.

Guidelines & Rules

No Children 7 years and under will be permitted to enter the hall. Babysitting will be provided.

Guidelines:

Failure to abide by the guidelines will result in team disqualification.

1. At check-in table, hand in the behavioral contract with the members' collective signatures, to the volunteer at the table.
2. Receive and wear your contest T-shirt

3. Enter the hall with all your team members quietly and calmly.
4. Wait for a volunteer to walk you to your table.
5. Remain seated till the MC starts the event.
6. Listen to the MC when he/she is speaking and look at the screen.
7. For the rounds, only the pen holder will write on the sheet provided on behalf of the team.
8. Stop sharing/discussing answers when alerted to do so.
9. No teasing or sarcastic remarks to other participating teams.
10. All cell phones should be turned off during the contest. No other devices should accompany the participants during the contest.
11. No food or drink inside the hall except water bottles.
12. General audience will be asked to leave the hall if they attempt to aid in answering the questions.
13. No noise outside of the hall as other levels will be in session.
14. Have a positive attitude towards other participants and show courtesy to volunteers, judges, and audience.

Contest Rules:

- Teams that do not abide by the contest rules will be given a warning and can be disqualified.
- Same gender teams are required, except in the cases of sibling-only teams.
- For a family team, only mahram family members can participate. No family friend is allowed to join the team unless all team members are the same gender.
- For level 3, friends teams can participate, but same gender teams are required, except in the cases of sibling-only teams.
- Children can participate in a family team if they are second grade and up. Younger children cannot be part of a team.
